

Bargaining Committee Membership



CITY OF OAKLAND ENGINEERS CHAPTER

The President, after consulting chapter officers, shall be authorized to appoint standing and ad hoc committees to address matters of common concern to chapter members. Such committees may include those established for the purpose of negotiations, grievance processing and review, chapter elections, political education and related matters. Such committees shall provide periodic reports of their activities to the President and the chapter.

CITY OF OAKLAND DEPUTY CITY ATTORNEYS CHAPTER

The President, after consulting chapter officers, shall be authorized to appoint standing and ad hoc committees to address matters of common concern to chapter members. Such committees may include those established for the purpose of negotiations, grievance processing and review, chapter elections, political education and related matters. Such committees shall provide periodic reports of their activities to the President and the chapter.

CITY OF OAKLAND ADMINISTRATIVE & PROFESSIONAL CHAPTER (A & W Units)

The Executive Board shall consist of the Officers, and the immediate past president. The Executive Board may initiate other ad hoc committees and appoint chairpersons as required. The duties of the Board are:

- Represent the Oakland chapter in contract negotiations and meetings with the Local Union and management;

- Coordinate collective bargaining issues and activities;

The purpose of the Ad Hoc Committees is to address a particular purpose or issue. These include but are not limited to:

- Contract Negotiations Committee – responsible for negotiation agreements between the Local Union and the City of Oakland.

CITY OF OAKLAND SUPERVISORS AND MANAGERS CHAPTER (H & M Units)

A Contract Negotiations Committee shall be established for negotiating agreements between the Chapter and the City of Oakland. The Contract Negotiations Committee shall be composed of the Executive Board and additional members and alternates elected by a majority vote of the Chapter membership.

The duties of the Contract Negotiations Committee are as follows;

- Represent the Chapter in contract negotiations and meetings with the Local Union and the City of Oakland;

- Coordinate collective bargaining issues and activities, and;

- Other contract related duties assigned by the President.
