Local 21 Members: Join Us to Learn more about the Tentative Agreement & Drop Off Your Ballot

After weeks of negotiations, the Public Employees Committee (PEC) and the City of San Francisco reached a tentative agreement on a comprehensive agreement, completing the 12 furlough day Framework Agreement announced on March 26, 2010. The full PEC agreement was reached in the face of the City's unprecedented \$483 million deficit, which was confirmed by PEC's independent Economist. It provides over \$200 million in savings to the City over the next two years to help close the budget gap and save jobs, while instituting improvements and efficiencies in the City's operations.

This is a vote by mail election. However, all members are invited to attend any of the ballot drop off locations below to **ask questions** about the tentative agreement and **drop of your ballot**. You must **bring your ballot with you** to vote at any of these locations. If you lose your ballot or did not receive a ballot, please call the Union office.

No agreement will be finalized without a ratification vote of the membership. Local 21 members may mail in their ballots, drop them off at the Union office, or bring them to any of the ballot drop off locations scheduled for the first week of May. Dropping off your ballot will ensure timely delivery before the voting deadline. All ballots must be received in the Union office by 5pm on May 7. Local 21's San Francisco Council overwhelmingly recommends a "Yes" vote.
